Program outline

The Vocational Graduate Diploma of Women's Health (VGDWH) is a nationally recognised training program that was presented for the first time in 2004. Each theme consists of ten evening sessions.

What does the program cover?

The program covers three themes:

1. Family planning and sexual health
03/02/09 - 07/04/09 (2010 dates TBC)
2. Office gynaecology
28/04/09 - 30/06/09
3. Non-procedural obstetrics
21/07/09 - 22/09/09

Who is the course suitable for?

The program has been designed to cover topics of relevance to non-procedural GPs, GP registrars, junior medical staff from KEMH and other doctors. Midwives and nurses working in women's health as well as practice nurses are also welcome to attend. At this stage the course is not available by correspondence for participants who are unable to attend in person.

In order to attain the VGDWH, participants are required to complete all three themes within one calendar year (attending a minimum of eight out of ten sessions per theme) and satisfactorily complete all assessment requirements. Further information on the assessments is available on request.

- Assessment and investigation of a couple with fertility problems
Male and female fertility issues
- Urogynaecology 1
 - a) The pelvic floor
 - b) Genital prolapse
- Urogynaecology 2
 - a) Urinary incontinence and management options
 - b) Recurrent urinary tract infections
- Pelvic pain - acute and chronic
- Menopause, HRT and alternative management
- Breast disease
- Causes and management of polycystic ovarian disease and premenstrual syndrome

The presenters are doctors and other health professionals with expertise in the topic area. The dates for each topic will be confirmed at a later date depending on speaker availability.
