Accessory nipples	Meconium ileus
Balanced translocation (in normal individual without developmental anomalies)	Metatarsus adductus (unless splinted)
Blocked tear duct	Mongolian blue spot
Birth mark, naevus, haemangioma (unless multiple or > 4cm – give size)	Oesophageal reflux
Broncho-pulmonary dysplasia	Paroxysmal atrial tachycardia
Clicky hips	Patent foramen ovale
Congenital pneumonia	Persistent fetal circulation
Delayed milestones	Perthe's disease
Deviated nasal septum	Pilonidal sinus
Ear anomalies (minor)	Positional/posture foot deformity
Epigastric hernia	Sacral dimple
Epilepsy	Short stature
Failure to thrive	Single palmar crease
Galactosaemia – Duarte Variant	Single umbilical artery
Hiatus hernia	Skin tag
Hydatid of Morgagni	Strabismus
Hydrocele testis	Thalassemia minor
Hydrops fetalis-immune (include if nonimmune hydrops)	Toe anomalies (minor)
Hypoglycaemia	Tongue tie
Imperforate hymen	Tricuspid incompetence
Inguinal hernia	Trigger finger/thumb
Intellectual disability	Umbilical hernia
Intrauterine growth retardation	Undescended testis (unless treated)
Intussusception	Webbing of 2 nd and 3 rd toes
Labial adhesion or fusion	Wide suture lines
Large fontanelles	Wolf Parkinson White Syndrome
