Service profile	<p>Albany Community Hospice is a dedicated facility for the provision of palliative care, end-of-life choices, education and support.</p> <p>A multidisciplinary team oversees the care of patients and the support of family.</p> <p>Medical care is provided by the patient's GP with support from Palliative Care Specialist.</p> <p>Care planning is provided in collaboration with the patient and family to meet their goals, including psychosocial and grief support.</p> <p>Admission may be for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• symptom assessment and management• end of life care• supportive care• psychosocial support.
Allied health services	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Support Coordinator for psychological and grief support• Referral to allied health professionals at the Albany Health Campus as required• Palliative Care Team Social Worker.
Admission criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Progressive life-limiting disease (malignant or non-malignant) with limited prognosis. Note that this is not a secure facility.
