Presentation	Tablet: 10mg Vial: 10mg/mL Oral Liquid: 5mg/mL (10mL containers) Oral Syrup: 5mg/mL (Aspen®)		
Storage	Store at room temperature, below 25°C. Protect from light

Dose	Refer to relevant KEMH Clinical Guidelines for appropriate dose regimes (links below)		
Administration	Oral Can be given with or without food IV injection Suitable IM injection Inject into a large muscle Subcut injection Suitable in palliative care patients as an intermittent injection or as a continuous subcutaneous injection. May cause pain and irritation at injection or infusion site. Refer to the Australian Injectable Drugs Handbook
