Topic areas covered include the following.

The impact of sexual assault and responding effectively to disclosures

Taking a medical and forensic history; forensically relevant questions

Consent

Early Evidence Kits (EEK) and specimen collection

Minimising DNA contamination

Medical issues after sexual assault including non-fatal strangulation

Injuries and injury documentation

Performing a general physical examination with collection of forensic specimens from the body

Genito-anal anatomy

Genito-anal examination demonstration and collection of forensic specimens

Completing the Forensic Specimen page(s)

Labelling, sealing and bagging specimens

Collecting clothing

Handing over of specimens

Writing a Police Report

Going to court
