## **Mental Health First Aid (MHFA)**

The MHFA course equips adults with the knowledge, skills, and confidence to recognise, understand and respond to a friend, family member, co-worker or another adult experiencing a mental health problem or mental health crisis.

This 12-hour course is run over **3 half days**, or **2 full days** and participants must attend all sessions in the series to complete the course. There is a cost associated for attendees from outside of WNHS: Public Health Staff \$150 per course, Private/ other staff \$300 per course.
