

Student Screening and Immunisation checklist - Category A staff

- Evidence must be provided to enable an assessor to verify compliance with OD388/12
- Acceptable forms of evidence are: AIR Immunisation history, vaccination cards, pathology laboratory reports and specialist's reports

Diphtheria tetanus pertussis (dTpa)	One adult dose of diphtheria/tetanus pertussis vaccine (dTpa) in the last 10 years	Serology will not be accepted	
Hepatitis B	History of completed age-appropriate course of hepatitis B vaccine	Anti-HBs ≥10mIU/mL	Documented evidence of anti-HBc indicating past infection
Measles mumps rubella (MMR)	2 doses of MMR vaccine at least one month apart	Positive IgG for measles, mumps and rubella	
Varicella	2 doses of varicella vaccine at least one month apart	Positive IgG for varicella	An Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) history statement that records natural immunity to chickenpox
Tuberculosis*		Interferon Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) + Clinical review for positive results by TB Service/Chest Clinic	Tuberculin skin test (TST) + Clinical review for positive results by TB Service/Chest Clinic
*TB screening required if the person was born in high TB incidence country, reside or work in high incidence country for more than 6 months, have had contact personal or at work with someone who is TB positive			
MRSA	Have you worked, or been a patient in health care facility outside WA in the past 12 months? YES NO If your answered Yes to either question, you will require MRSA swab If MRSA is isolated see your GP for management		

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
